Gospel reading 16th February 2025. Sunday 6 C: Luke Chapter 6

Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.

There are two accounts of Jesus' beatitudes or blessings. You might like to compare them. Matthew Chapter 5 with Luke chapter 6 that we read today.








Welcome Baby Freddy McDonald to the Ballyroan parish family. A great day was had by all!
