Every year we welcome children into our parish through the sacrament of Baptism.

Our Second Class pupils from Scoil Naomh Pádraig and Ballyroan Boys National School make their First Holy Communion in May every year. They engage in four preparatory 'Do This In Memory Of Me' masses which are organised by parent volunteers.

Our Sixth Class pupils from the two local national schools receive the sacrament of Confirmation in March/April every year. Pupils have the opportunity to join the 'Do This In Memory Of Me' and Confirmation choir each year.
