Our Gospel reading is from Mark, (the earliest and shortest Gospel). The writings are more straightforward, perhaps less spiritual than John and more based on what we might imagine the evewitnesses of Jesus shared. This reading is an invitation for reflection on how we live out our faith. There were lots of rules within the Jewish faith, that Jesus did not believe mattered above 'You shall love your God with all your heart...' (Deuteronomy Ch 6) and 'religion that is pure... is to care for orphans and widows' (James Ch1) We know how important praying together as a community is, but our readings are a warning not to allow our religion to become 'merely cultural, an empty shell, if our heart is not in it.'


As the Gospel tells us: We must not honour Jesus just with our lips, and not our hearts! Reflection by Deacon Frank.
