**Sunday Week 30B. 27<sup>th</sup> October 2024**

**Our Gospel reading is from Mark 10:46-52**

**We read about the blind beggar Bartimaeus (the son of Timaeus), who has his life changed by Jesus.**

Perhaps the key words from Jesus are ... ***Go your faith has made you well.***

The story ends after the young man, Bartimaeus has his sight restored, and he becomes a follower of Jesus. Theologians tell us that the fact we know his name suggests that Bartimaeus may have been one of the eyewitnesses that contributed to Mark's Gospel. While Jesus did amazing things in his short ministry, what is important is the gift of faith, the insight to know that Jesus is the Messiah. The recovery of sight in biblical stories is often a metaphor for coming to faith and a deeper understanding of who Jesus is.
