Gospel reflection Sunday 12^h October C28: Luke CH:17(11-19).

The theme of our Gospel story is about mercy and salvation.

Luke's Gospel tells us about how Jesus cured the ten lepers, but only one returned to thank Jesus. The one that returned was a Samaritan, a Jewish sect that were looked down upon by the Jews.

The message is clear that the Kingdom of God is open to anyone who has faith in God and receives the message of Jesus Christ our saviour. The story highlights both the physical healing of the ten but also bringing them back into their community and restoring their dignity.
